**The 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Krewe of Athena’s Mardi Gras Ball will be held on Saturday, January 29<sup>th</sup> at the VFW Hall on Country Club Rd. in Lake Charles.** The theme is: **“Caribbean Cuckoo!”** and remember that this is a costume ball. Think of any variety of costumes related to a Caribbean or Calypso-style theme, which means that these costumes should be fun! *It should be a fun birthday celebration for Sandy Parker, too!!* **The “5<sup>th</sup> Avenue Band” from Lafayette will play from 8 til Midnight (check them out at [www.the5thavenueband.com](http://www.the5thavenueband.com))** Donald Greenwood and Southern DJ Services will also be handling the presentation music and the band-breaks’ music. The doors will open at 6:30 the night of the Ball and will close for entry at 7:10 (no later than 7:15). NO ONE will be allowed to enter until after the presentation is over. Please be respectful of the Royalty, Princesses and Gents and do not try to enter during the presentation because the Krewe Reps will have to get firm with anyone who tries. Plan to be there before the doors close so that you will have ample time to find your seats and prepare for the evening. You should also advise your guests of this requirement so that they will not be upset if they arrive too late and cannot get in. *Wrist Bands are making a comeback, so everyone entering the Ball will be required to wear one.*

**Enclosed is the Reserved Seating form that needs to be returned by Friday, December 31st.** The tables will be the standard rectangle tables that will be placed in groups of 16 (2 tables together) and they will be only 4 rows deep from the dance floor, so no one will be too far from the dance area. Your entire group will be able to sit in the same area and the number of table groupings will vary, depending on your total numbers.

**The tickets and seating assignments will be ready for pickup on January 16<sup>th</sup> from 3 – 7 pm at Ramona’s house in Sulphur.**

Also enclosed is the Order Form for Krewe T-shirts. Please remember that krewe shirts are *not* to be worn as a costume for the Mardi Gras Ball.

Deidre Begnaud (and her Lacassine/Iowa connection/s) is in charge of the Ball decorations and we’ll let everyone know when to be at the VFW Hall to decorate. Additional information about decorating your own tables will be in your ticket packets when you receive them in January.
